- 2- Please do not forget to upload the documents required during the evaluation of your application; otherwise it will not be considered. All students are expected to upload transcripts. In addition, if you have additional score-earning documents from the table below, please upload them as well, as one merged document.

EVALUATION PROCESS AND THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE GRANTED STUDENTS

Erasmus student selection and granting is carried out by ranking the scores from the highest to the lowest, taking into account the evaluation criteria and weighted scores announced by the National Agency, among the students who meet the minimum requirements. In this election, it is planned to support **1 students for study**.

All students will be invited to language Exam by our institution on May 21st and 21nd, 2025.

The election results will be announced in the application system and our website. The criteria are described below:

2. Language Exam

An English language will be organized for all the applicants. All the applicants are obliged to attend the exam.

The language exam has two steps: the written and oral exams.

Please upload your report about your disability that +10 score will be applied when calculating your final score

COUNTRY OF DESTINATION AND GRANTS

- 1- Individual Support Grant: Students who are entitled to mobility as granted are supported with an individual support grant, which will contribute to the expenses to be incurred during the Erasmus mobility process, during study activity, around five months, 700 Euro monthly.
- 2- **Travel Support:** Students who are entitled to mobility as granted are supported with an individual support grant, which will contribute to the expenses to be incurred during travelling. The support is calculated according to the distance between destination city and Istanbul and is **310 Euro. If the student prefers to use low carbon transportation vehicles, there will be a top up on 310 Euro.**
- **3- Additional Grant Support:** Additional Grant Support may be provided to disadvantaged participants in addition to the grant they deserve. In order to be able to grant the individuals, the disadvantaged participant should be defined as an individual with limited economic and social opportunities and who fits into the following sub-categories.
 - 1) The participants who have a decree of protection, care or housing in accordance with Law No. 2828 of the Ministry of Family and Social Services (provided that it is documented).
- 2) Students for whom protection, care or accommodation decision has been taken within the scope of Child Protection Law No. 5395
- 3) Those who do not have other parent income and receive an orphan's pension
- 4) Being the children of martyr and/or veterans
- 5) It is sufficient to submit a document proving that the student received financial support from municipalities, public institutions and organizations (Ministries, Social Assistance and Solidarity Foundations, General Directorate of Foundations, Kızılay, AFAD) when applying for Erasmus to himself or to his family).
- 6) Disabled students
- 7) Students who have one of their parents or their guardians, who are over 65, and who receive disability or needy pension within the scope of the Law No. 2022, dated 01.07.1976, on Pensions for Needy, Powerless and Orphaned Turkish Citizens and Disabled and Needy Turkish Citizens
